Welcome aboard – Arrive to the Port side of Ocho Rios cruise terminal to a traditional welcome. You will receive your passports from our Purser before making your way through immigration.

SKOPELOS - GREECE



A MISE-EN-SCENE ISLAND.

Eye catching landscapes, crystal clear waters next to golden coasts, traditional Pelion architecture, rugged natural landscapes and pure island atmosphere are what Skopelos adds up to. As the island's mostly covered in pine forest, the colour green will definitely cast a spell over you. Its part of the Sporades islands, its ancient Greek name was Peparithos, son of Dionysus and Ariadne, who is believed to be the island's first inhabitant, while its name today was given in Ptolemaios script in the 2nd Century .AD.

Skopelos' strongest card is its jaw dropping beaches with pine trees touching its turquoise waters. The island gained international acclaim when Hollywood producers chose it to shoot the famous movie "Mama Mia" establishing it as a holiday destination for travellers coming from around the world!

DAY 4

PHUKET, THAILAND

THE PEARL OF THAILAND.



The Island of Phuket (pronounced Poo-ket) is often called the Pearl of Thailand, and once you set foot on the pristine beaches and see its crystalline blue water you'll understand why. Your day in Phuket should start with a visit to Kata Noi beach a smaller more secluded spot great for an early morning swim in this sun drenched paradise. Next head to nearby Karon viewpoint for unparalleled views of the Andaman sea and the areas mountainous landscape. Then head into town to see the Big Buddha of Phuket. The white marble figure stands 45 meters tall, from there visit the temple of Wat Chalong and its Grand Pagoda where it's believed a splinter of bone from the Buddha himself resides. This afternoon we take a tall boat to "Ko Khao Phing Kan" less formally known as "James Bond Island". The famous limestone cliffs that jump vertically out of the emerald waters was relatively undisturbed until 1974 and it's starring role in the James Bond classic "The Man with the Golden Gun".
